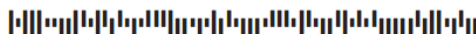

RESPONSE REQUIRED BY FEDERAL LAW**

<FirstName><LastName>, you have been randomly selected as a prospective juror for the United States District Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania. Serving on a jury is both an honor and responsibility of American citizenship and federal law requires you to complete a Juror Qualification Questionnaire to determine if you qualify to serve as a juror in federal court. 28 U.S.C. §1864(a).

Please complete this questionnaire online within ten (10) days of receipt of this postcard by going to the court's website, www.pawd.uscourts.gov, and clicking on the "E-Juror" link, located in the menu to the left of the "Welcome" message. You can also scan the QR code on the front of this postcard with your smartphone and it will take you to the site to complete the questionnaire. You will need your nine (9) digit participant number, located above your name on the front of this postcard. **You will not need to provide your Social Security number.** If you do not respond within the required 10 days of receipt, a paper questionnaire will be mailed to you with directions for you to complete and return for processing.

If you qualify, you may be summoned to appear for jury service at a later date. At that time, along with your summons, you also will receive information regarding the daily attendance fee (currently set at an initial rate of \$50 for each day of service) and associated mileage and/or other travel reimbursements to which you may be entitled.
