


## Getting Started

Zoom works best on a mobile device such as a SmartPhone or Tablet that has a built-in camera and microphone. Zoom will also work on a personal laptop/desktop that has a camera and microphone.

To fully participate, you only need to install the Zoom app on your SmartPhone/Tablet or install the Zoom software to a Windows or Mac laptop/desktop.



## Testing Your Device

## How to Connect

Using the device which you installed the Zoom application on, **click on the meeting link.**

	<p>When you join the meeting, the microphone button above will look like this, click on it, and follow the prompts to connect audio to the conference.</p>
